*DCI* is a non-profit organization. It was founded in 2003 to improve the socio-economic, educational and health conditions of underprivileged children in the United States and World wide.

*DCI's* mission is to prevent child labor and ensure that children receive proper education and health care. All of *DCI's* programs work towards its' goals of educating children and providing healthcare. In addition to helping the disadvantaged children, *DCI* is also working to help their families, schools, and communities.



*DCI* humbly reports that with the support and generosity of many people like you they are able to help countless underprivileged people with their following programs:

- ***Sun Child Sponsorship Program (SCSP) and Orphan Support Program (OSP)*** - supporting 1100 children and their families in Bangladesh.
- ***Child-hood Blindness Prevention Program (CBPP)*** - aids children and infants suffering from eye disorders, especially congenital cataracts.
- ***Health for Underprivileged Program*** - provides aids to families who live in the slums of Dhaka, Bangladesh.
- ***Emergency Disaster Relief and Rehabilitation Program (EDRR)*** - supports the villagers whose homes and livelihoods are repeatedly destroyed by cyclones or floods.

*Accomplishments in 2009 in Bangladesh:*

- (1) 1100 underprivileged village children were able to continue their education.
- (2) 2350 underprivileged village children received free health care.
- (3) 330 Orphans received health care & education support.
- (4) 2900 disadvantaged children received free eye care
- (5) 3800 Dhaka City slum residents received free health care & medicine.
- (6) 500 villagers of Patuakhali district whose homes and livelihoods were destroyed by Cyclone Aila received relief & rehabilitation support.

### **Help Children Learn:**

- \$12 per month (\$144 per year) can provide a child education and healthcare.
